Financial Policy and Procedure- Tuition

Student responsibilities:

We value each student's decision to pursue training through PI. Enrollment is a commitment that needs to be executed faithfully. Purpose Institute expects students to act responsibly with their financial obligations.

Campus responsibilities:

The Dean has oversight of all activities of the local campus to ensure and maintain the PI standards. The administrator is responsible for posting attendance to the website and requesting expense reimbursements.

District responsibilities:

The District Administrator works with each local Dean and Administrator to ensure that the financial policy and procedures are followed.

New Student Registration:

- One-time, non-refundable fee of \$50.00.

Class Tuition:

- One course \$120.00
- Two course \$240.00
- Three courses \$360.00
- Four courses \$480.00

Graduation Fee:

One-time, non-refundable fee of \$50.00 for each diploma, whether Foundational or Advanced.

Payment Method:

The method of tuition payment is online through the website using a credit card, debit card, or pre-paid credit card.

Payment Schedule:

- Registration fee must be paid before course enrollment.
- Registration, course enrollment, and tuition payments are accepted online only.
- If not paid in full, tuition balance automatically adjusts into 4 equal payments (with a \$3.00 per payment service fee)

- Additional payments can be made at any time, for any amount.

Tuition Non-Payment:

- Students with a tuition balance will be denied enrollment until balance is paid in full.
- Website access and graduation requests will be denied for non-payment of tuition.

Dropped classes:

- The Registration Fee (\$50) is non-refundable.
- Students who ONLY attend one weekend of classes are responsible for 25% of that semester's total tuition.
- Students who attend classes two or more weekends are responsible for the entire semester's tuition.
- Tuition may be refunded for dropped courses in the case of an emergency, at the discretion of the Campus Dean.

Tuition (Spousal) Grants:

- A Spousal Grant of \$108 per course will be applied to the tuition of a student whose spouse is enrolled and is paying full tuition in the same course. The spousal tuition is \$12 per course.
- The \$50 one-time, non-refundable registration fee and the \$50 graduation fee apply to all students including grant recipients.
